



## **Outgoing - Customer acceptance of Covid-19 Risk Waiver**

You agree that by making a payment on your holiday booking, you acknowledge and confirm that you are willing and agree to travel and participate in your booked holiday/trip during the Covid-19 pandemic and therefore, you further agree and confirm that:

1. You acknowledge that there is an additional risk associated with travelling during the Covid-19 pandemic and as such you may be at an increased risk of being exposed to Covid-19 from other travellers , during travel and/or at your destination.
2. You have checked, reviewed and are aware of the latest travel advice from the UK government, the Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office (FCDO) and locally with regards to your chosen destination and have decided to book and pay for your holiday/trip.
3. You shall comply with all rules, regulations, laws and requirements imposed on you, whether by UK or other government or regulatory authorities, suppliers, airports or ports, in relation to Covid-19, including but not limited to any requirement on you to self-isolate, whether in destination or upon your return to the United Kingdom, to submit to a Covid-19 test (including temperature testing or a swab test) or to provide contact details for the purposes of track and trace.
4. You have purchased travel insurance which includes cover for certain Covid-19 related issues or incidents which may affect your travel arrangements including cancellation before or during travel, and you have read and accept the insurance policy wording and understand what you are and are not covered for.
5. You will not travel if you are experiencing symptoms of covid-19 or have tested positive or are required to self-isolate/quarantine and if, symptoms of Covid-19 develop and are present during your trip/holiday or you test positive or are required to self-isolate or quarantine then we reserve the right to amend your holiday booking accordingly, i.e. refuse onwards coach travel or refuse admission to accommodation, venues etc.
6. This waiver does not affect your statutory rights.
